Here you will find Georgetown's equine treasure, Little Silver Charm, a miniature horse with a big personality.

DINE: Downtown Georgetown is lined with ten locally owned restaurants and sweet shops, perfect for appealing to everyone appetite. *Groups are encouraged to drop off at the Georgetown/Scott County Museum and allow some extra time to explore Main Streets many shops.*
